




GTR's Decarbonisation Roadmap

Govia Thameslink Railway and Network Rail Southern Region are working together to decarbonise the routes we operate and achieve carbon net zero targets by 2050. Both organisations have created carbon reduction programmes and are working together on joint initiatives and collaborative projects to ensure a whole-system industry approach to tackling climate change. To do this we will:

- Publish our net-zero plan by Spring 2023
- Review options for renewable energy installations on our stations and depots by December 2023
- Develop and launch science-based targets by March 2024
- Convert all lighting to LED where feasible by 2030
- Have all natural gas assets replaced by 2040
- Achieve full net zero by 2050
